
Thursday May 5th — meet at central Stockholm at 8::00 to take the bus out


Background

Ekskäret grew out of a vision of the financier

and entrepreneur Tomas Björkman. Tomas wanted to create a platform for a new kind of meetings and conversations about society's big issues. Based on this vision, he created the Ekskäret Foundation.

The Foundation takes its name from the island Ekskäret in the Stockholm archipelago owned by the foundation. The island has a conference facility that was completed in 2011.

The island Ekskäret



Ekskäret is located in a nature reserve in the Stockholm archipelago. The island has a varied scenery and the buildings are specially designed to inspire meetings and discussions, as well as reflection of thoughts and ideas in solitude.

Responsible for the design has been the architectural firm Landströms who specializes in nature-friendly architecture. The buildings are made entirely of wood and have irregular angles and levels adapted to the terrain. In 2011, Ekskäret was nominated to the

Swedish Association of Architects' prize for best building.

The facility has 22 bedrooms with 39 beds, a large meeting room for up to 40 people, two smaller rooms for 5-10 people and a combined studio and dining room. In addition several areas around the island are suited or created to use for activities, meetings and reflection in solitude: the barbecue area, the sauna, the boathouse with its writing room, the lookout tower, two beaches, forests and rocky outcrops.



Philosophy



The cornerstones of Ekskäret's business are: the sustainable society, personal development and "curious exploration".

– A sustainable society means for Ekskäret a society where many different ways of looking at the world can co-exist. Rather than be guided towards certain goals, we believe that a sustainable society is characterized by listening and learning from each other instead of discussing who is right or wrong.

- Personal development is, we believe, necessary to understand the complexity of a sustainable society. Thanks to a close

cooperation with our mission partners we have access to methods of personal development based on scientific knowledge in fields such as psychology and neuroscience.

- "Curious exploration" is about searching new experiences and perspectives, and having conversations where the goal is to listen and learn more. Curiously exploratory conversations are not about winning arguments, or that someone needs to change his mind, but it is about to continue asking, without expecting a "right" answer
